- Traffic lights & traffic management

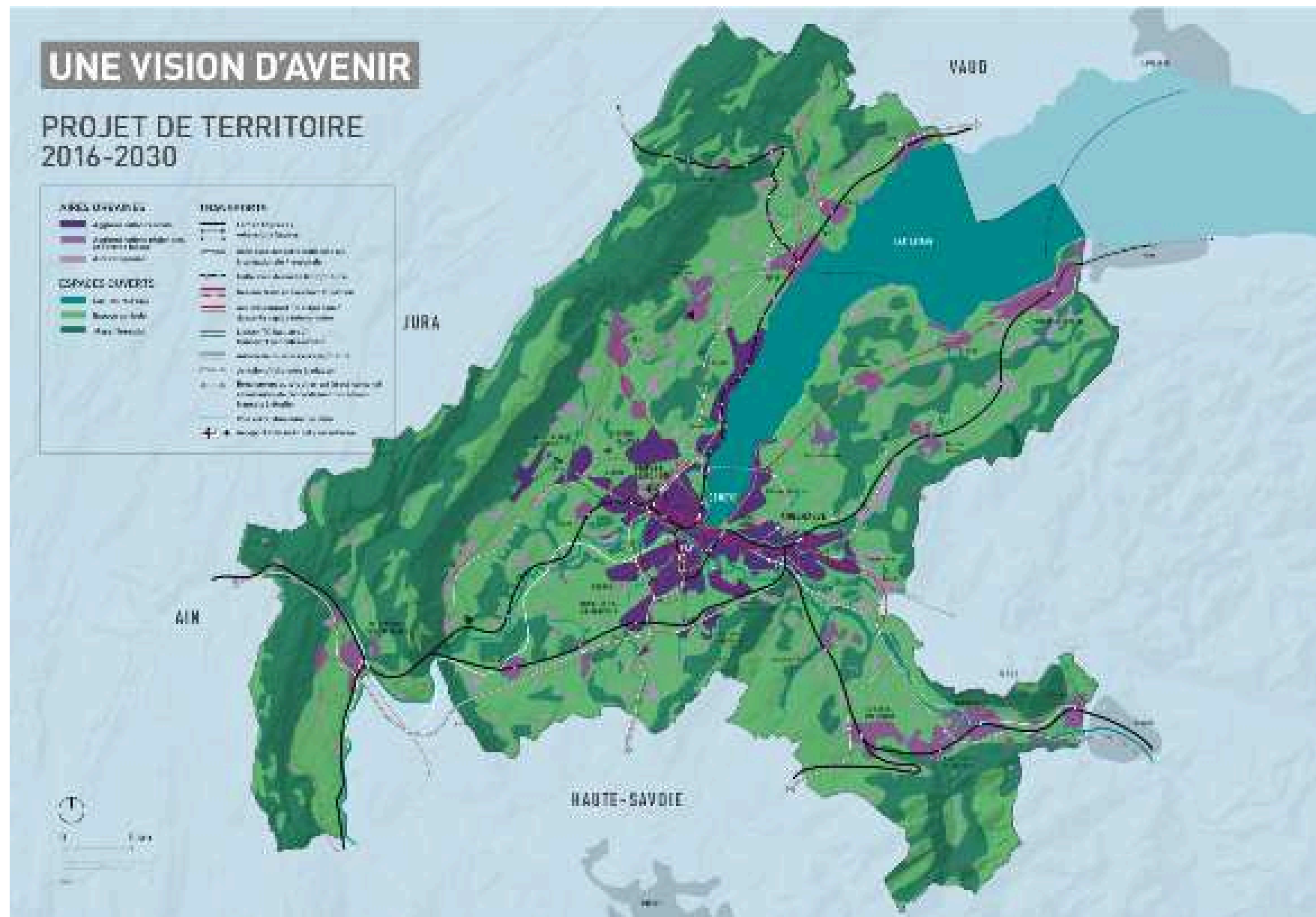
Global mission for transport & mobility development in cooperation with 45 municipalities

Supervision of 2 autonomous public entities :

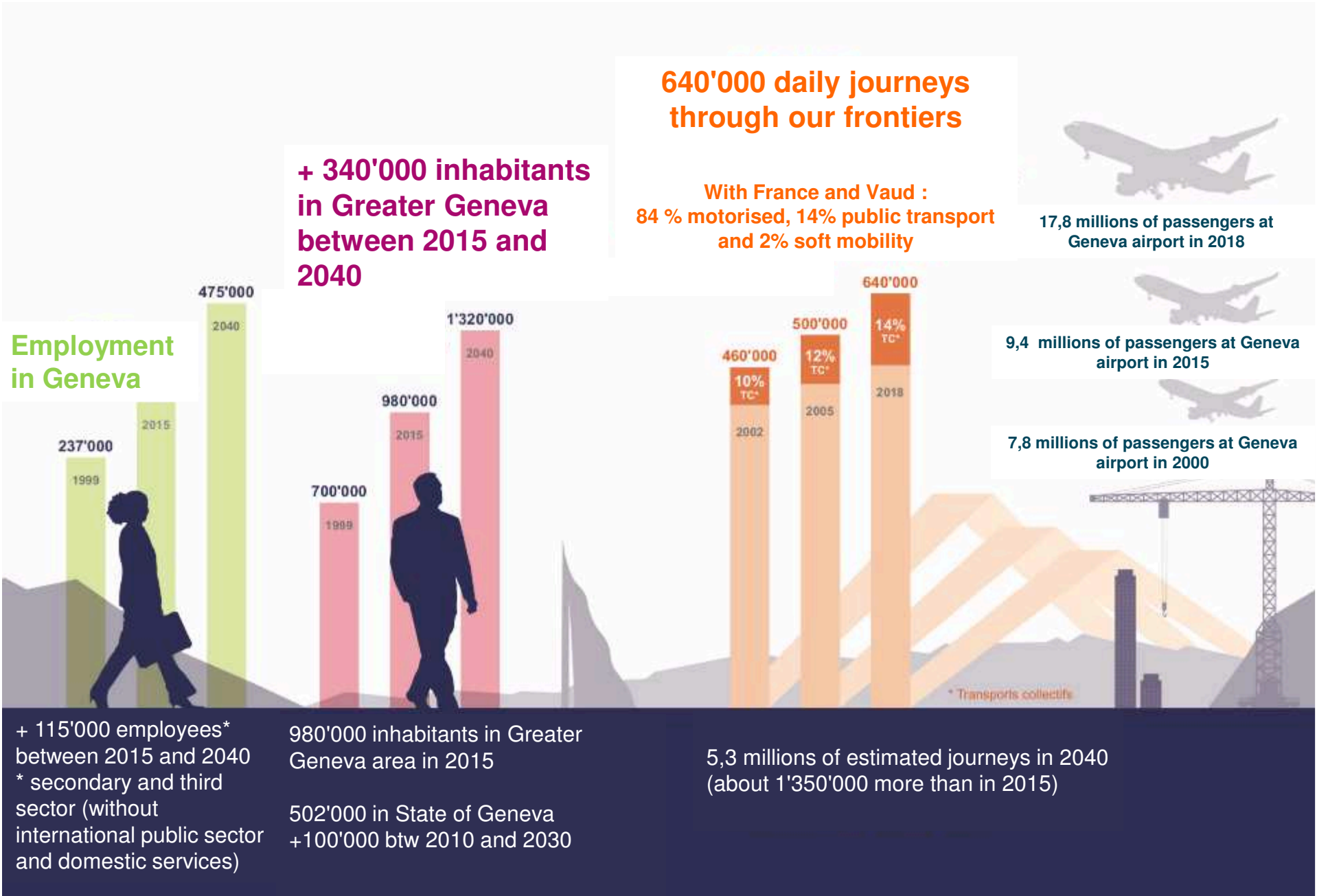

INTERNATIONAL GENEVA : A MAJOR KEY PLAYER

- ~ 33'000 employees including ~ 26'000 in international public sector
- 5 billions CHF expenses in our Canton
- 25% of our economy for 15% employment
- 5% employment growth this last 3 years
- 259 diplomatic missions or delegations
- 37 international organisations
- 179 States

Historic political compromise

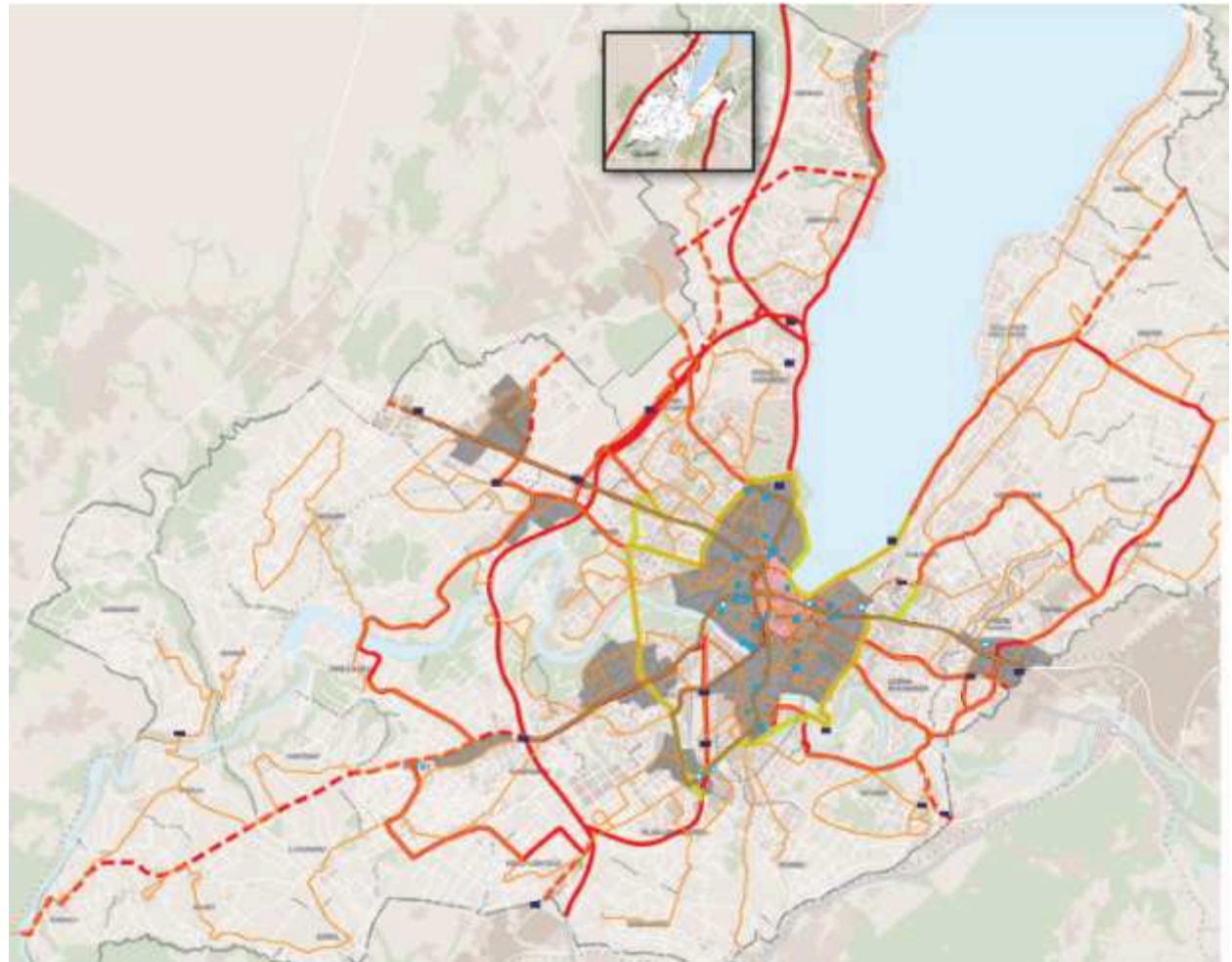
Zone 1 : heart of Geneva city

- ✓ Transit traffic restriction & car traffic control
- ✓ Reduced speed areas
- ✓ Priority to soft mobility, pedestrian areas and public transport

Middle belt road system

 - ✓ Reducing congestion
 - ✓ Fluid flow & multimodal lanes

- Projects implementation over a period of 10 years (2020 – 2030)

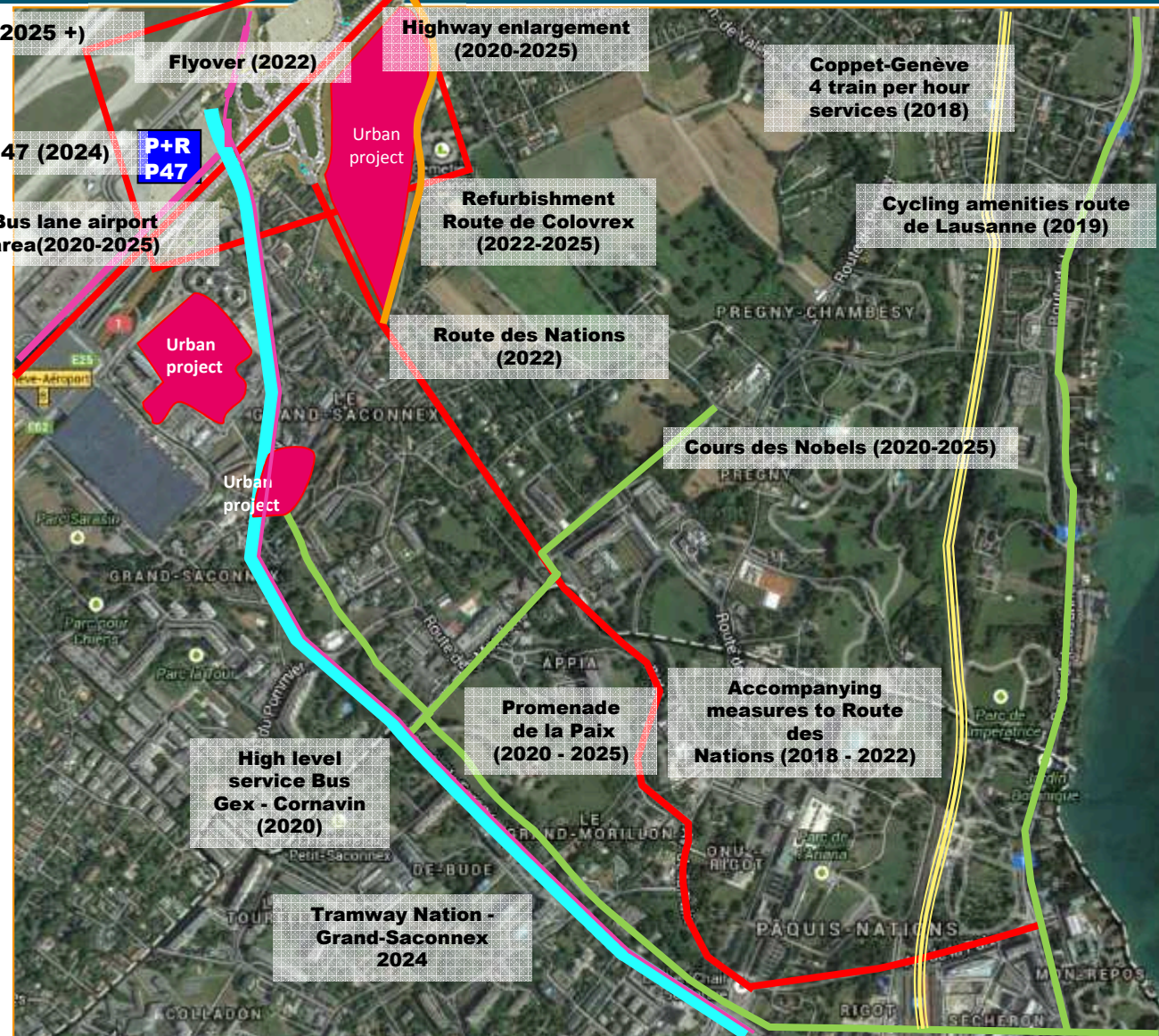

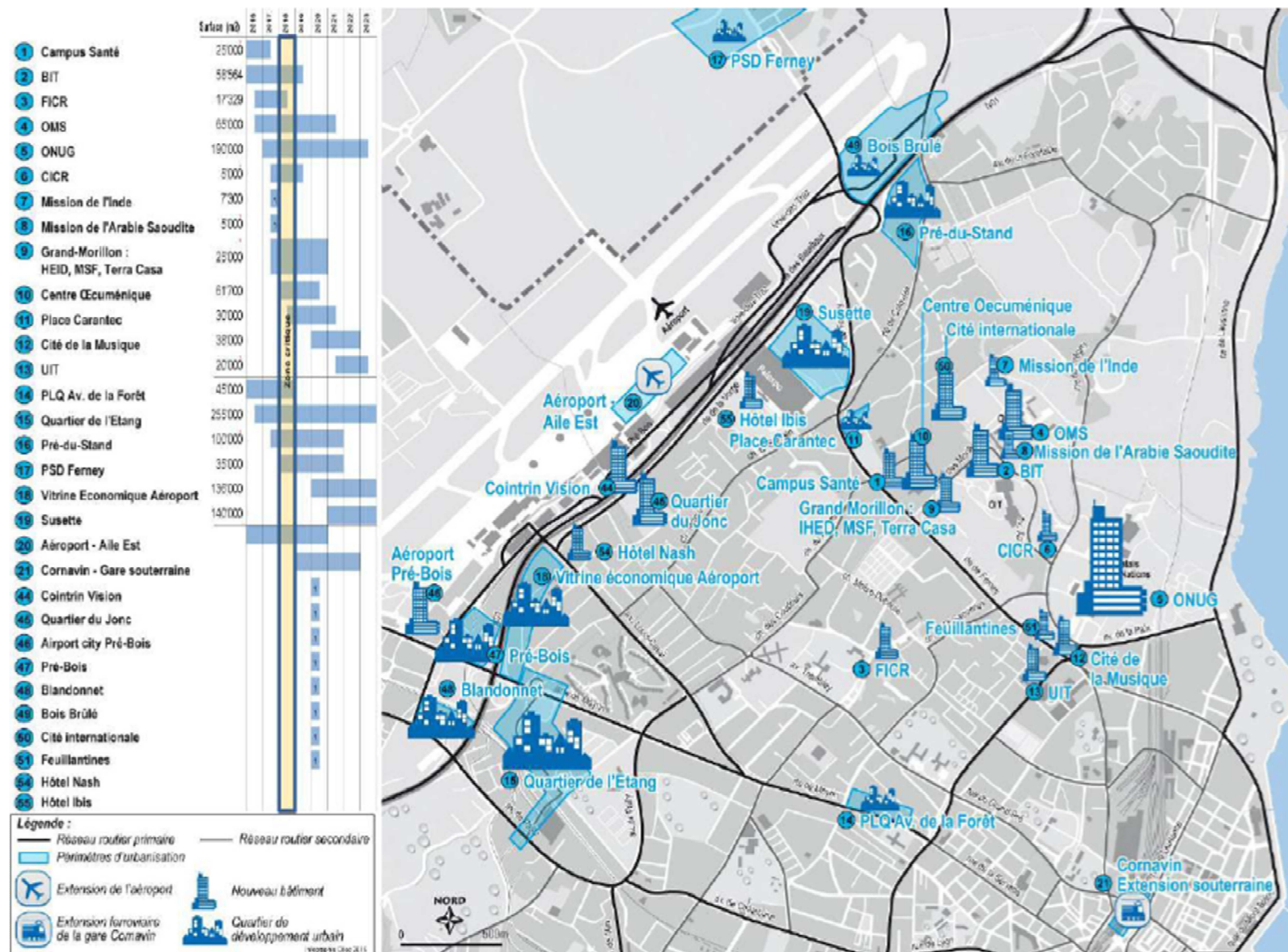

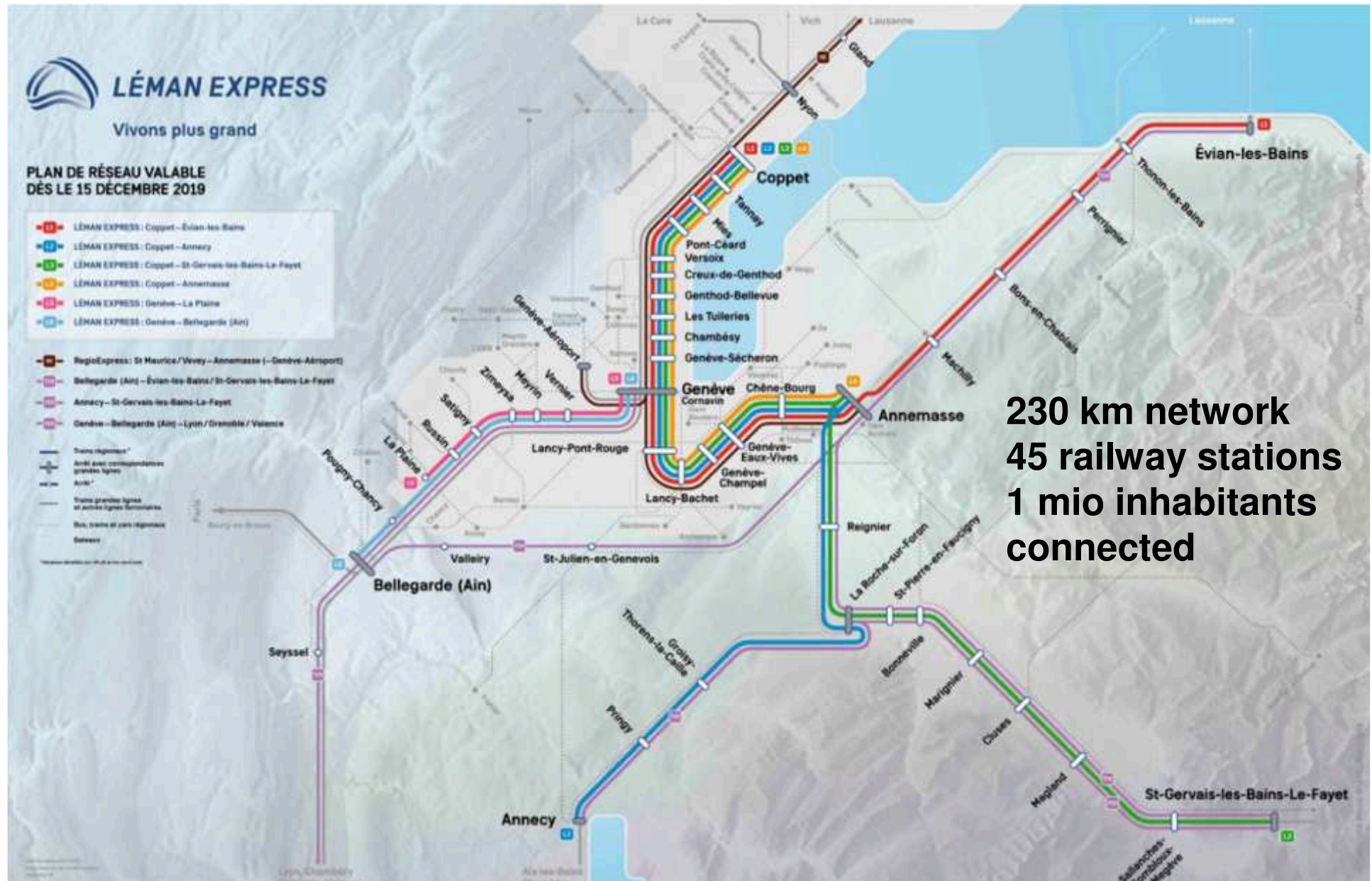

DEVELOPMENT OF NEW TRANSPORT HUBS



New bus & tramway routes (including cross-border lines)
+ 20% capacity to 2024

A cross-border and integrated pricing system

NEW BUS CORRIDOR ON ROUTE DE FERNEY

End of 2019 this is :

- 900m (about 0,6miles) of new bus lane
- Frequency growth for bus F line (Gex to Nations) to 7'30 (+ 10' currently)
- New route for 5+ (to Park&Ride P47)
- More parking spaces on Park&Ride P47 (up to 300)

New amenities :

- More reliability
- More frequency
- More space for bus travellers
- Less travel time (30% off between Ferney-Voltaire and Geneva main station)

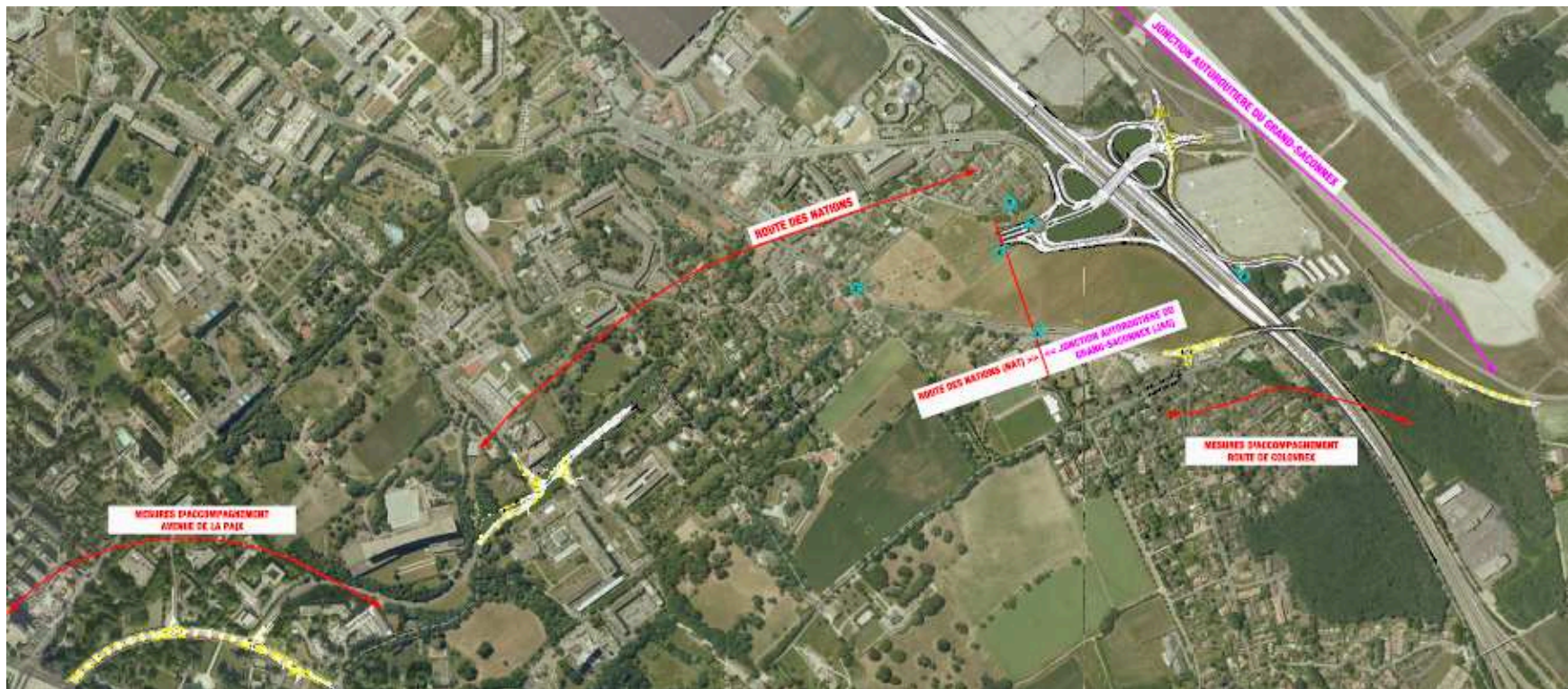


Traffic jam may occur in the area during the firsts months of implementation

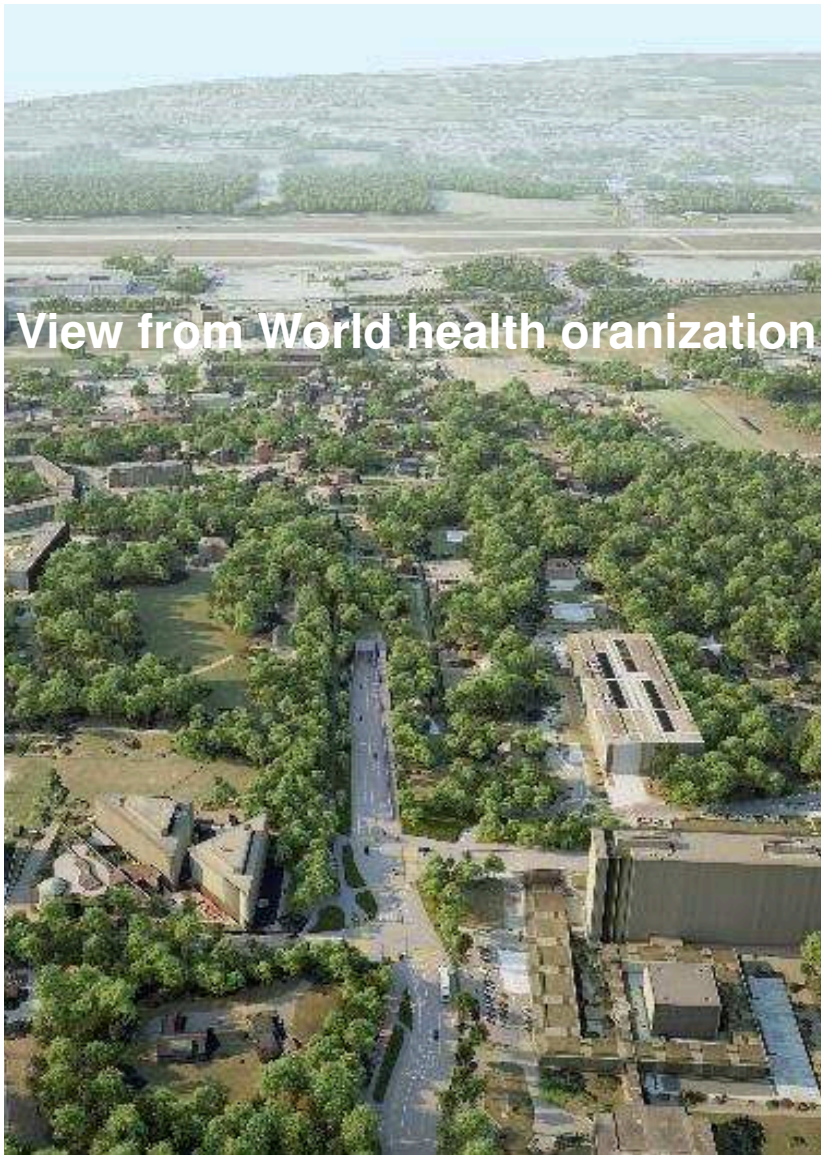
ROUTE DES NATIONS / ROAD OF NATIONS

In 2022 this is :

- A major infrastructure project, mainly underground
- A new link between the highway, the airport and Place des Nations in the heart of the international Geneva
- A reconfigured flyover
- Over 300 millions CHF investments



ROUTE DES NATIONS OPENING IN 2022



- No crossroad or traffic light from highway to WHO
- New amenities on Avenue de la Paix
- Reduction of traffic disturbances through Grand-Saconnex



TRAMWAY 15 : NATIONS – GRAND-SACONNEX

- An attractive, reliable, accessible tramway to promote modal shift from car
- Increase of public transport capacity on this saturated corridor

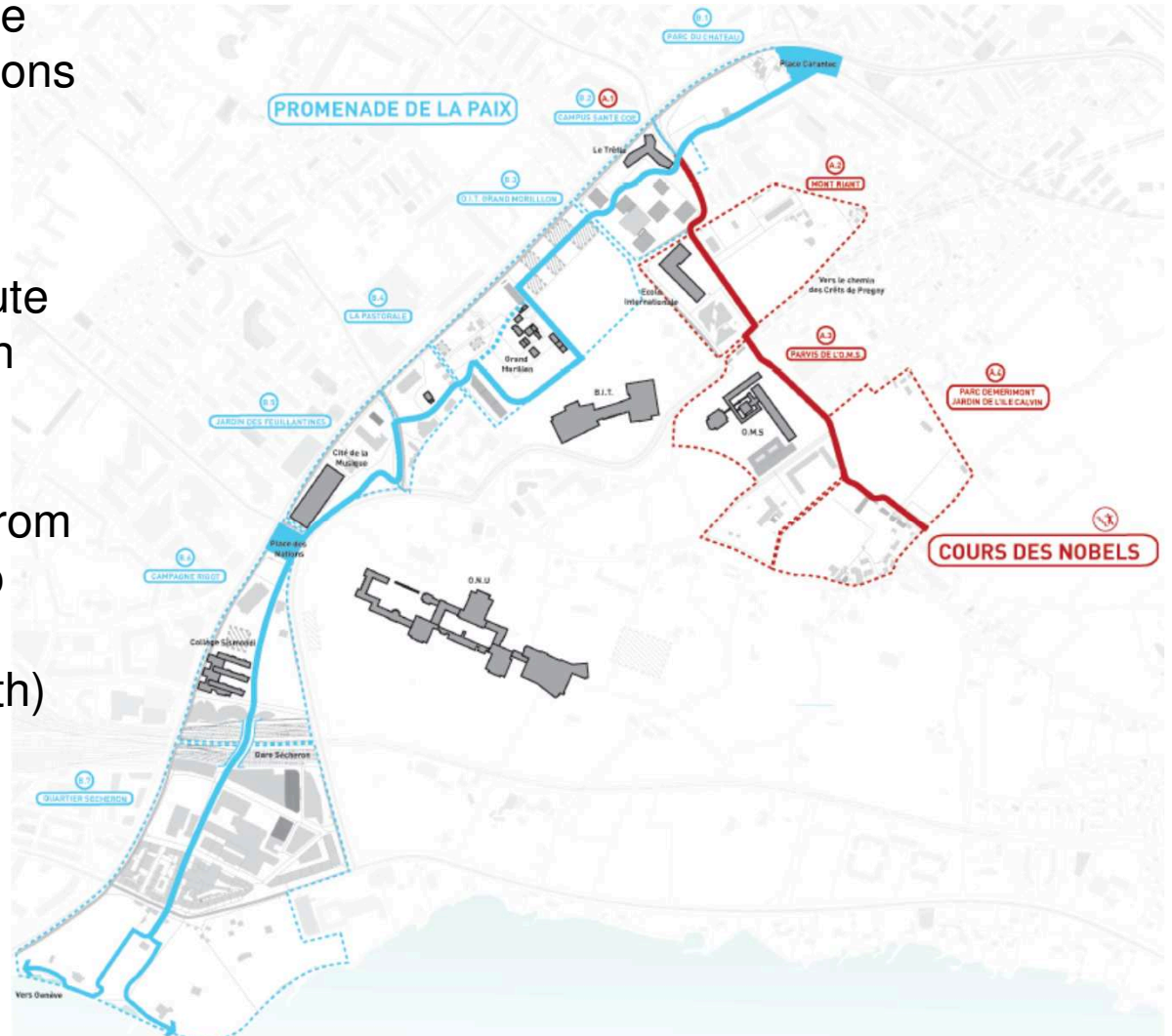


- A major crossborder corridor to be equipped for soft mobility (bikes, pedestrians)
- A transformation of the public space of the road of Ferney
- Due to open by end of 2024. A further extension to Ferney-Voltaire is discussed for an opening in the following years.

NEW CORRIDORS FOR PEDESTRIAN AND BIKES

Two new corridors are about to be implemented into Jardin des Nations till 2030 :

- ✓ "Cours des Nobels" from Pregny-Chambesey to Route de Ferney (mix pedestrian path and bike)
- ✓ "Promenade de la Paix" from la Perle du Lac Garden to Carantec Place in Grand-Saconnex (pedestrian path)



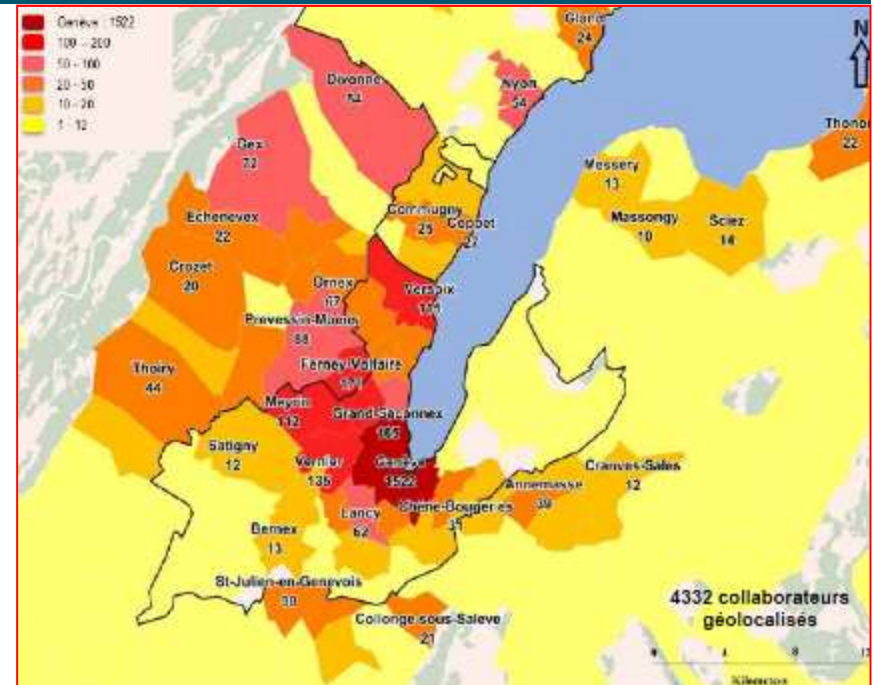
These soft mobility projects will be accompanied by a complete corridor (pedestrian and bikes) along tramway extension (15) on Route de Ferney

GENEVA INTERNATIONAL FOR MOBILITY

Since 2012 we have launched a global survey and participative actions for new and sustainable means of transport for international employees (mobility plans)

Main goals are :

- Upgrade our knowledge on use of transport into international Geneva
- Motivate a modal shift from individual means of transport to the other modes
- Put in common the resources, find synergy to decrease the costs (financial, environmental) and enhance mobility efficiency
- Integration towards a global mobility strategy
- Adapt our transport policy to the specific needs of the international community

- New railway station at Geneva main railway station (Cornavin)
- New road Montfleury in Vernier
- Highway enlargement and flyover refurbishment from "Perly" to "Le Vengeron"
- New infrastructures in the Airport area
- Development of new Park&Ride in Greater Geneva area
- Large cycle paths through the State of Geneva from Ain (01) to Haute-Savoie (74) in France
