A favorable environment

Geneva attracts many film productions


- ▶ 50% of production in French-speaking Switzerland is already carried out in Geneva
- → 733 direct jobs, including production and post-production
- Twice the national average in terms of share of jobs

A high-quality ecosystem

Geneva has a dynamic audiovisual sector

- Wide range of expertise, stakeholders, and networks
- Production and post-production companies
- Cinéforom, Fonction Cinéma, the Digital Creation Hub, RTS
- Numerous festivals with national and international reach
- Specialized academic institutions (HEAD, SAE Institute, etc.)

An already well-known filming location







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Becoming more competitive:

Competitive Situation

- Strong competition between regions to attract production
- Incentive mechanisms in several cantons
- Other European regions offer similar incentives

Eco'Diagnostic Analysis 2024

- In-depth study of the audiovisual sector in Geneva
- Need to establish an incentive scheme
- Double lever: financial support + institutional structure

Strategic Objectives

- Enhance the attractiveness of the canton of Geneva
- Support local sector growth
- Maintain leader position in French-speaking Switzerland

Ambitious goals



Macroeconomic

- Stimulate growth in the audiovisual industry (AVI) to increase economic benefits in Geneva
- Strengthen synergies between local and international actors
- Attract private investment



Local

- Strengthen the diversity of Geneva's ecosystem
- Stimulate business creation and job creation



Structural

- Ensure the consolidation of the AVI branch in Geneva
- Encourage the development of local infrastructure

A lever for cultural influence

- Audiovisual media are an essential vehicle for cultural and regional influence.
- As a multicultural canton with a strong artistic tradition and international visibility, Geneva has all the necessary assets to further establish itself as a major hub for co-production and creation.
- This mechanism will enhance the visibility of Geneva's culture on the national and international stage.

Geneva Film Commission

A system based on three pillars

- → Geneva Film Office
- Cash rebate mechanism
- **→** Cantonal Audiovisual Commission

Geneva Film Office

A facilitation and promotion structure

- → Attractiveness Simplifies production procedures (concierge service), reduces production times, and facilitates filming
- ➡ Visibility Promotes Geneva and the Geneva Film Commission at international festivals and events. The Film Office is affiliated with the Geneva Tourism & Congress Foundation

Cash Rebate Mechanism

Reimbursement of eligible local expenses

- → Up to 30% for audiovisual productions, in line with international standards
- Maximum of 500,000 francs per project

Economic impact

Return on investment

- ⇒ Benefits for the local economy based on a multiplier effect ranging from x3.5 to x4.5 for every franc spent
- → Promotes economic consumption in Geneva shops and hotels and restaurants in the canton
- Development of the local ecosystem → promoting the attraction of large-scale international productions

Serving professionals

Cantonal incentive fund for audiovisual media

- Funded by the Canton and potential contributions from other public authorities, including the City of Geneva, or private funds
- Managed by the Department of Economy and Employment

Cantonal audiovisual Commission

- Official commission composed of representatives of the parties involved in the Geneva Film Commission as well as relevant economic sectors
- Evaluates funding applications

Eligibility criteria

Spend locally

- Expenses must be incurred with entities established within the canton to be eligible for reimbursement
- Minimum expenditure threshold

→ Meet objective ethical criteria

 Only audiovisual productions that respect federal and cantonal laws in force would be considered eligible for suport
