FIVE GOOD REASONS TO RECYCLE KITCHEN WASTE



Its sorting is simple and easy thanks to the "Little green bin".



It makes up for more than one third of the contents of our dustbins.



Treating it costs less than incinerating it.



It contains over 90% water and cannot be processed in an incineration plant.



Its repurposing makes it possible to produce biogas and compost useful for farmers.
